Proposal One, an Amendment Amendment to Protect Against Unequal Treatment	County Proposal Number One Alters Certain Voting Requirements in the Erie County Charter							
This proposal would protect against unequal treatment based on ethnicity, national origin, age, disability, and sex, including sexual orientation, gender identity and pregnancy. It also protects against unequal treatment based on reproductive healthcare and autonomy.  A "YES" vote puts these protections in the New York State Constitution.  A "NO" vote leaves these protections out of the State Constitution.  <div>Yes <input type="radio"/> No <input type="radio"/></div>	Requires that the county legislature impose the state authorized 1% and 0.75% sales and compensating use tax by simple majority vote instead of presently required affirmative vote of two-thirds.  A “YES” vote adds this simple majority vote requirement to the Erie County Charter.
