It also protects against unequal treatment based on reproductive healthcare and autonomy. A "YES" vote puts these protections in the New York State Constitution.					Requires that the county legislature impose the state authorized 1% and 0.75% sales and compensating use tax by simple majority vote instead of presently required affirmative vote of two-thirds. A "YES" vote adds this simple majority vote requirement to the Erie County Charter.
